

1-Each panel in PDF format should not exceed 1MB, is it correct?

The server will not allow you to upload files bigger than 5mb, you can try to upload files up to that weight.

2-The list of key concepts/ideas must be put on one of the panels?

Yes, the list has to be on the panels.

3-Are PDF files obligatory or I can send only image?

Yes, both are obligatory (PDF and JPG).

4-Which are the copyrights of the author in the contest?

The entries must never have been made public previously, nor should it be submitted simultaneously for any other competition. Copyrights on the entries remain the property of their designers, and the organizers of the competition retain the all rights on the publishing of these entries.

5-Is the written description considered to be included into the A3 panels or can it be separate?

Yes, the written description has to be included in the A3 panels.

6-If I am not yet graduated is it possible to still win the scholarship?

Yes, we can hold the master for a following edition.

7-Being a student makes it necessary to have a team leader who is already an architect, or a professor? Or i can participate without any foreman?

Students can participate without any architect as leader.

8-Is it obligatory to project our ideas on an existing city?

Preferably yes; but you can also send proposals for utopian cities.

9-I've already made my registration, should't i receive a notification note?

10-If a team with more than one member, wins the competition, do all the members get the Master?

It's only one master per project.

11-How should we identify the panels?

We suggest you to put a title to help the jury to easily identify the proposal, but is not required. An automatic code will be generated from our system.

12-The group is formed with more that one member, do we all need to be inscripted or just one of us?

13-How many proposal can a person send?

You can send several proposals as a collaborator but just one as Leader.

14-Does the jury differentiates in any way between architect's proposals and student's proposals? Or are architects and students treated in the same way?

The jury does not make differences, architects and students are treated equally.

15-Only students are allowed to participate?

No, also professionals are allowed to participate.

16-If I win, must I accept all the prizes? If I don't accept it, am I disqualified?

If you don't accept the master the prize goes to the next finalist.

17-High school students may participate in this contest?
